

NELSON GARDEN DAY

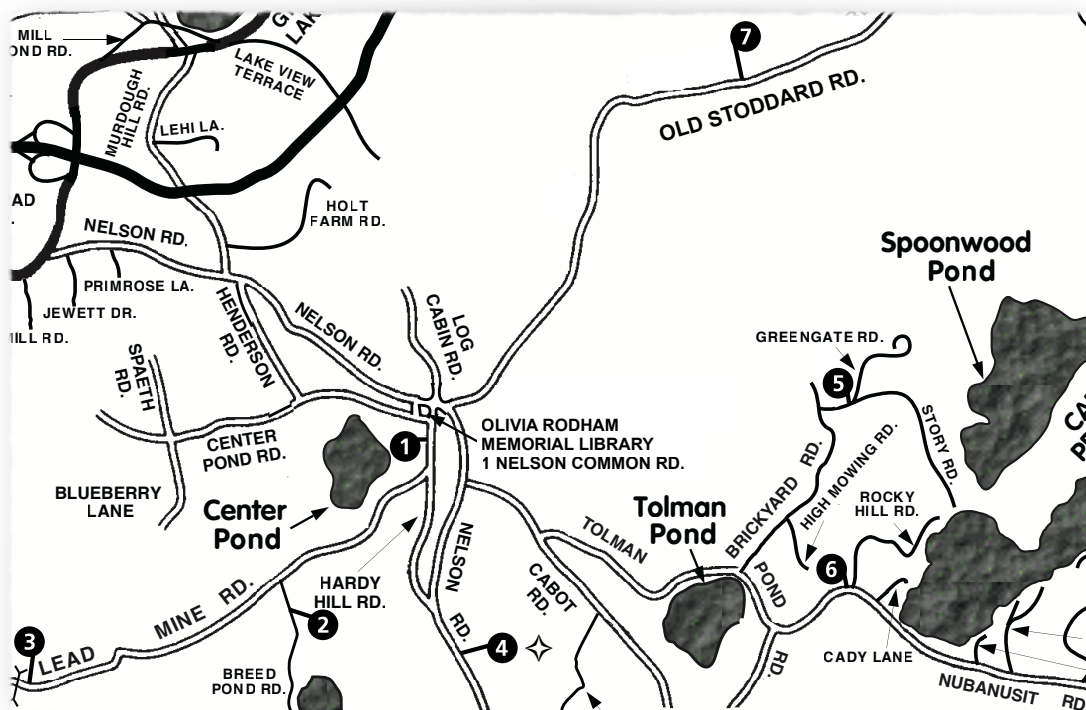
SATURDAY, JUNE 17, 2017 ~ 10:30 - 4:00
